Happy Holidays everyone! It's that time of year where we try to give to others. We give cards to our members that are 85 years old and older. We used to send along a poinsettia plant but since Covid we instead include a donation to a worthy cause. This year a donation will be made to Food4Kids on behalf of RTOERO District 11.

Due to widespread hunger and lack of affordable and/or supportive housing, please consider dropping off some food items to your local Food Bank.

Recently, we had a very successful District 11 Luncheon at Golf's Steakhouse. We honoured the Canadian Clay and Glass Gallery that won this year's Community Grant for \$4000. We matched the grant with District 11 funds, so we presented Denis Longchamps with an \$8000 cheque for the Gallery. Please check out their website for their many seniors' programs that are offered.

The golfers will know that this September was the last RTO District 11 Golf Tournament. Next week, each of our three hospitals (Cambridge Memorial, St. Mary's and Grand River) will receive a \$5000 cheque from the proceeds of the tournament. Over the last 25 years, our hospitals have received approximately \$240 000.

NEW Extra coverage for trip cancellation/interruption - As of September 2023, members can now add extra coverage for trip cancellation. You are covered for \$6000 per insured person, but now you can buy extra coverage up to \$12 000 per insured for a specific trip. You can choose single, couple of family coverage. For full details including the premiums and application, please go to the RTOERO website or call 1-877-406-9007. In addition, RTOERO has made a partnership with Telus. Starting in January 2024, Telus will offer members a special deal on buying phones and on phone packages. Again check the website for details.

As of January 2024, RTOERO members who have RTOERO insurance will not have to pay the RTOERO member fee. Those who do not have RTOERO insurance will still have to pay it. Again, check the RTOERO website for more details.
